

# 2010 Australian Central Community Lottery Terms and Conditions

**The Australian Central Community Lottery is a Community Support initiative of the Australian Central Credit Union.**

1. The Lottery is conducted under license issued by the Office of Liquor and Gaming in South Australia and under special dispensation granted by the Minister of Racing and Gaming, Northern Territory.
2. License number M12030.
3. The Lottery is conducted under regulations governing Major Lotteries as published by the Government of South Australia. These regulations can be found at [http://www.olgc.sa.gov.au/Lottery/Major\\_Lotteries/majorlottfacts.pdf](http://www.olgc.sa.gov.au/Lottery/Major_Lotteries/majorlottfacts.pdf)
4. 100% of all proceeds benefit participating Charities, Community Groups, Sporting Clubs, Schools and Pre-Schools.
5. Ticket sales open from 1 February 2010 and close on 30 June 2010.
6. There are 700,000 issued at a cost of \$2.00 each.
7. Tickets are available for purchase from participating organisations within the State of South Australia and the Northern Territory.
8. Information collected from ticket purchases is solely for the purpose of informing prize winners and shall not be used for any other purpose.
9. Public draw will take place at Westfield Tea Tree Plaza Shopping Centre on Saturday, 24 July 2010 at 11.00am.
10. Results will be published in the Sunday Mail on Sunday, 25 July 2010, Messenger Newspapers on Wednesday, 28 July 2010, and the NT News and Centralian Advocate on Friday, 30 July 2010. Results will also be posted on the Australian Central website (<http://www.australiancentral.com.au>) from 2.00pm on Saturday 24 July 2010.
11. All prizes are valued at the manufacturers recommended retail price.
12. In the event of a prize no longer being available at the conclusion of the lottery, the prize winner shall be offered a similar product at the same or greater recommended retail value,
13. All unsold, lost and unaccounted tickets are removed from the draw and therefore ineligible to win prizes.
14. Prize winners shall be notified in writing within four days of the draw, advising claiming and collection of prizes
15. Chances of winning a prize in the Community Lottery are 1 in 4242
